This geometric poster by Abram Games was designed in 1976 to encourage people to visit the tigers at London Zoo, but all the shapes have got jumbled up!

Can you help us put one of our favourite posters back together?

Option I— With a printer

Print this page out (in B&W to save ink) and carefully cut out the shapes. Arrange them back into the tiger from the poster. This may take patience and trial and error! When you're finished, stick them down on a piece of paper and colour it in.

Option 2—Without a printer

You get to be more creative! Cut out lots of shapes of similar sizes and play around with arranging them. Use the poster as inspiration to build your own tiger or another animal. When you have your shapes arranged, stick them down on a piece of paper and colour in.
